The Venue

Bad Münsteriefel is a historical spa town in the Eifel mountain range. It is one of the rare towns in the Rhineland region to have kept its medieval ramparts intact. The town is small enough to see everything by just strolling around it. The whole town is confined within the 13th-century city walls, which have been remarkably well preserved.

The conference venue "ProCom Eifelzentrum" is located just above Bad Münsteriefel and offers best conditions for conferences or seminars.

How to get there

Bad Münsteriefel is located 15km south of Euskirchen and 50km south-west of Cologne. It can easily be accessed by the E29 (A1) motorway. Take the E29 (A1) towards Euskirchen/Trier and leave at Exit 112 (Bad Münsteriefel/Mechernich).

There is a train line, from Bonn, of which Bad Münsteriefel is the last station. The journey takes 1h10min. You can also take a train from Cologne and change at Euskirchen.

Bad Münsteriefel provides accommodation with a wide range of choice of categories and prices, a youth hostel and a camper van site.

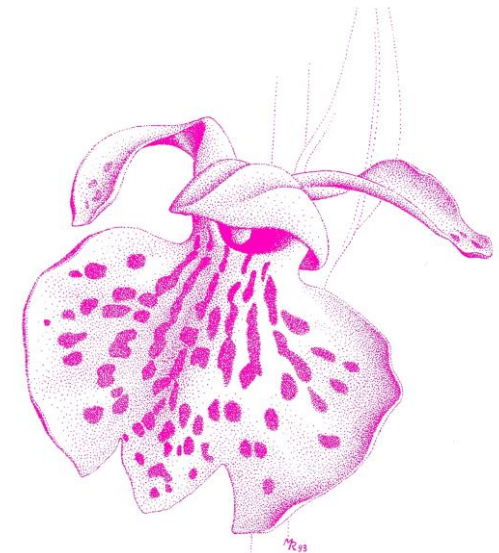
